## INPUTS [

Resources dedicated to or consumed by the program

e.g.

- q money
- q staff & staff time
- q volunteers and volunteer time
- q facilities
- q equipment and supplies

Constraints on the program

e.g.

- q laws
- q regulations
- q funder's requirements

## ACTIVITIES [

What the program does with the inputs to fulfill its mission

e.g.

- q feed & shelter homeless
- q provide job training
- q educate the public about signs of child abuse
- q counsel pregnant women
- q create mentoring relationships for youth

## OUTPUTS [

The direct products of program activities

e.g.

- q number of classes taught
- q number of counseling sessions conducted
- q number of educational materials distributed
- q number of hours of service delivered
- q number of participants served

## OUTCOMES

Benefits for participants during and after program activities

e.g.

- q new knowledge
  - q increased skills
  - q changed attitudes
